### **Vision**

“Dedication towards sustainable generation of various forms of electric power, e.g., hydro, solar, biomass, wind, etc. and supply of reliable electricity to all parts of the country through efficient transmission and distribution lines.”

### **Mission**

To achieve the long-term vision and overcome its challenges, the Ministry of Energy, Government of Nepal has set the following mission:

- Build a power generation capacity that can meet domestic energy needs in a sustainable manner.
- Create a culture of energy conservation and responsibility.
- Ensure the generation of economic and affordable electricity for domestic, commercial, and industrial use by using indigenous resources.
- Minimize pilferage and adulteration in fuel supply
- Promote world class efficiency in power generation
- Create a transmission network
- Minimize inefficiencies in the distribution system
- Minimize financial losses across the system

- Align the development partners, involved in energy sector and improve the governance
- Conservation of water, minimizing wastage and ensuring its more economic and equitable use

**The identified goals of the Mission are:**

- (a) Comprehensive energy-source-data base in public domain and assessment of impact of climate change on such resource;
- (b, ) Promotion of citizen and state action for energy use efficiency; and water conservation, augmentation and preservation;
- (c) Focused attention to vulnerable areas including over-exploited areas;
- (d) Increasing water use efficiency at least by 20 percent, and
- (e) Promotion of basin level integrated water resources management.
